

ASBCYC Memorial Day Cruise at Prisoners Harbor May 29 & 30 2010



We had so much fun last year we are doing it again! Yacht Clubs from Channel Islands Harbor, Ventura Harbor and Santa Barbara Harbor will converge at Prisoners Harbor over the holiday weekend for a combined club cruise. This will be a great opportunity to get acquainted with your “neighbors” and share the splendor of Santa Cruz in the spring. The coreopsis are in bloom, the Island Scrub Jay’s are abundant (especially in the eucalyptus trees) and the Island Fox are seen regularly. Last year we had 40 boats from 5 clubs, 92 people and three humpback whales feeding in the anchorage for two days!

We will be having a “host boat ice breaker social” on Friday night, every morning cruiser net on VHF 72, a 1 mile guided kayak trip to Pelican Bay, a beach picnic on Saturday afternoon with horseshoe and cribbage tournaments, prizes, a commemorative wine bottle for each boat, a guided hike through Nature Conservancy property with beautiful stands of Toyon and Manzanita and a special award presentation. We will also have “Prisoners Port Captains” to assist in their dingy’s with anchoring if needed.
