NOTICE OF RACE

Anacapa Yacht Club invites you to enter the 2007 St. Patrick's Day Race, the first of AYC's scheduled races for 2007. This race offers the best of spring racing followed by AYC's famous post-race corned beef & cabbage dinner, accompanied by a DJ playing Irish music. The race starts in the vicinity of the Mandalay buoy, and offers random leg courses for spinnaker, non-spinnaker, and multihull classes. Hope to see you on the water!

DATE: Saturday, March 17, 2007. The start signal for the first class is scheduled for 1100 hours.

COURSE: Random leg courses will be chosen from the 2007 Anacapa Yacht Club Course Chart (to be provided at the skippers' meeting). The starting area will be in the vicinity of the Mandalay buoy.

CLASSES: PHRF-handicapped Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker classes and an ORCA-handicapped multihull class will be formed with class breaks determined by entries. Other classes may be formed at the discretion of the Race Committee. This is a PHRF Category 3 event, and area A Random Leg Course ratings will be used. PHRF membership is not required for non-spinnaker class entries. The Race Committee will assign, for this race only, handicaps for Non-spinnaker boats without valid PHRF certificates.

ENTRIES: The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008*. The PHRF MIR Rule does not apply. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting, which will be held at Anacapa Yacht Club promptly at 0830 hours on the day of the race. Registration will be accepted by mail or from 0800 to 0830 hours prior to the skippers meeting. Spinnaker class entries must be accompanied by a valid 2007 PHRF Certificate of Handicap. The entry fee of \$30.00 includes one (1) dinner ticket for the post-race corned beef and cabbage dinner.

SKIPPER MEETING: 0830 hours at Anacapa Yacht Club.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded in each class at the post-race dinner at Anacapa Yacht Club.

SOCIAL: No host bar and a fantastic corned beef & cabbage dinner after the race.
