Class A Spinnaker: Yellow Class Flag

Class B Non-Spinnaker: Red Class Flag

- 1754 Alert (multiple horns) (time approximate-intervals as follow)
- 1755 Warning Class A Flag with horn
- 1756 Preparatory Flag (blue with white center) with horn.
- 1759 Preparatory Flag down with long horn.
- 1800 Start Class A flag down with long horn.
- 1801 Preparatory Flag with horn.
- 1804 Preparatory Flag down with long horn.
- 1805 Start Class B Flag down with horn.

4.	Start	Gina	Finish	7.00 NM	
5.	Start	Windward	Hueneme	Finish	6.60 NM
6.	Start	Gina	Hueneme	Finish	8.00 NM
7.	Start	Windward	Gina	Finish	8.40 NM
8.	Start	Detached Breakwater	Finish	1.00 NM	
9.	Start	Windward "A"	Finish	2.50 NM	

- All marks are to be left to **Port**.
- Windward "A" will be a temporary mark approx. 1 NM on course 270 Mag.
- If there is a floating **Orange Mark** near Hueneme Buoy round it instead.
- When rounding Gina, you must also take its westerly white anchor buoy and any associated objects to Port.
- **Give way to all Commercial Vessels near Gina and Hueneme Buoy.**
- If the finish line is in front of Anacapa Yacht Club add 0.5 NM.
- Enter the harbor from either end of the detached breakwater.
